Understanding The Application of the Faith Process

Introduction

We have thoroughly studied the various components of faith and we are now ready to put them all together. As previously stated, systematic faith is the strategic application of the process of faith as taught by Jesus Himself. When the application of the principle is fully understood, there is a lesser possibility of there being faith failure along the way. This lesson will highlight the day to day application of faith to bring the covenant promises of God to pass.

I. The Regiment for Victorious Faith I John 5:4

**Def. Regiment – a disciplined course of action that is established to achieve a predetermined objective. II Pet. 1:10 The Christian walk is a disciplined lifestyle!*

A. Expectations of the Regiment of Faith Heb. 11:1

**Faith expectations are the forerunners of the manifestations of the faith process!*

1. Wisdom – accurate application of knowledge, naturally and spiritually
2. Favor – the divinely motivated assistance of others using their power
3. Miracle – the supernatural intervention of God suspending natural laws
4. Plan of Action – series of steps to bring the acquisition of the desire
5. Strength to Endure – spiritual wherewithal to patiently stand fast

B. Established Order for Releasing Faith (For Material Promises) III John 2

1. Know that it is the Will of God to bless you with material blessings
2. Find the Scriptures that promise you material blessings
3. Write them down and read them out loud
4. Pray a prayer based on the promises in Scriptures for the object of faith
5. Fashion and Speak a confession of faith in agreements with the Word
6. Explore what can be done in the natural to acquire the thing

7. Thank God daily for what you believe you receive as a sacrifice of praise
8. Sow financial seed for wisdom and favor for this acquisition
9. Keep your thoughts in agreement by meditating on the Word of God
10. Listen to teaching tapes daily on material prosperity. **Rom. 10:17**
11. Confess the wisdom God and know that God orders your steps
12. Avoid debates with those who don't believe. **Titus 3:9**
13. Find a natural example and learn from their successful efforts. **Heb. 6:12**
14. Diligently follow the natural order to the full extent of your integrity
15. Don't get frustrated in the process, and remember results are progressive
16. Chart your progress and rejoice at each step you make toward your goal

C. Established Order for Releasing Faith (For A Health Promises) Ps. 107:20

1. Know that it is the Will of God to Heal You
2. Find the Scriptures that promise your Healing. **Ps. 103:1-3, I Pet. 2:24**
3. Write them down and read them out loud
4. Pray a prayer based on the promises in Scriptures for healing
5. Fashion and Speak a confession of faith in agreement with the Word
6. Explore what can be done in the natural to bring healing
7. Thank God daily for your healing as a sacrifice of praise
8. Keep your thoughts in agreement by referring to the Word of God
9. Listen to teaching tapes daily on God's will to heal **Prov. 4:22**
10. Avoid debates with those who don't believe. **Mark 5:40**
11. Follow the orders of the doctors it will not affect your faith
12. Get others who understand faith to agree with you for your healing **Matt. 18:19**
13. Don't panic of healing is not instantaneous results are progressive **John 4:52**
14. List symptoms and rejoice as each one disappears. **Is. 57:19**
15. Maintain an attitude of faith throughout the process. **Prov. 17:22**

Conclusion

The diligence and tenacity of the Believer during this waiting process is what patience is all about. You can do everything you are supposed to do and still have not received the promise because of the incubation process of faith. Those who are patient know that delay is not denial. The Scripture bears witness that it requires both faith and patience to receive from God. Is anybody standing in faith for something that has not manifested yet???
